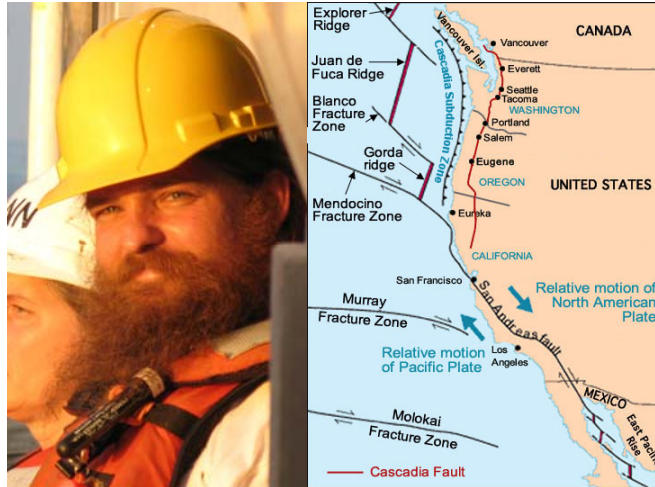

The San Andreas fault system intersects southwestern Mendocino County and is about 5 miles offshore of Fort Bragg. The Cascadia subduction zone is about 65 miles to the north. Jason will review tsunami and earthquake hazards for coastal Mendocino County in relation to both fault systems. Many of you might remember the earthquake in April of 1992 near Cape Mendocino. This is a smaller scale of what we might expect in the future.
