Here are some instructions about how to submit a discussion “Thread” and how to comment using a “Post” on a comment “Thread.”


Everyone needs to submit a discussion “Thread” and then to read some Threads and submit a “Post” about one of the “Threads.”

1. Click on the appropriate Online Activity # (The link below the Course Name).

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
